

Intellectual property rights and protection are usually associated with corporate and business environments; it also has an important role to play for creative in the entertainment industry.

Musicians, singers, and producers earn money through sales of the music or merchandise. Other than these, they can also make money through five performances and tours. The role of intellectual property rights comes in because it is easy to copy and sell music. It is not uncommon to find piracy in the entertainment industry, and even more so in the music industry.

In intellectual property rights, there are three things that are usually discussed the most: copyrights, trademarks, and patents. In the case of music, patents are not relevant. Copyrights and trademarks are of importance, especially copyrights, since they have a very major role to play for the artist's earning.

Copyright protection is extremely important for any musician. Copyright protection protects the sound and the written work of the musician for the lifetime of the owner of the copyright and then an additional sixty years after the owner's death. In the case of a group of owners, the sixty years are added after the passing of the last owner.

Copyright protection includes books, songs, poetry, sound and video recordings, and more. For music creative, this is extremely important. It serves as a proof of ownership and prevents producers and musicians from being robbed of their own work. Intellectual property rights awards artists' security against others copying their creation. The work

cannot be copied unless the musician or the recording studio authorizes it. Distribution and broadcasting is also done with the permission of the composer and serves as a source of revenue. Authorization must be obtained to use the composition for works like movies.

Trademark protection is the protection of a design, a phrase, or even a word. Trademark protection can be very useful to protect logos and brand names. Musicians often use logos on their albums and their merchandise. This makes trademark protection necessary for them. In order to be able to use a logo or design as a trademark, it must be used enough times to be easily associated with the musician.

It is very important for musicians and producers to understand intellectual property in order to ensure that their work is protected. This is what enables musicians to earn money from their own works, either in the original form or in altered forms. Even though it may seem tedious to get into the legal aspects of the music industry, it is necessary for musicians to make informed decisions in order to ensure they are not taken advantage of.

Without doubt, one of the elements that contributes to any artist's success is the team that supports them. It is necessary for an artist to ensure that a music attorney is a member of this team. 



# INTRODUCTION AND HISTORY OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS IN INDIA

In commemoration of World IPR Day, the IPR Cell in collaboration with IQAC organized a Online Special Lecture on Intellectual Property Rights on 26/04/2021 at 6.30 p.m. It was conducted through Team Link Platform. The history of intellectual property rights in India can be traced back to the British colonial period when the first copyright and patent laws were introduced in the mid-19th century. However, these laws were primarily designed to serve the interests of British entrepreneurs and did not take into account the needs and aspirations of Indian inventors and creators.

After India gained independence in 1947, the government took several steps to promote indigenous innovation and creativity and protect the Intellectual Property Rights for indian citizens. In 1957, the Indian Patent Act was enacted, which established a system of patent registration and protection that was more accessible and affordable for Indian inventors and entrepreneurs.

In the 1960s and 1970s, the Indian government implemented a series of policies to promote self-reliance and reduce dependence on foreign technology and capital. These policies included the development of indigenous technologies, the creation of public research institutions, and the establishment of a legal framework that allowed for the compulsory licensing of patents in certain cases of national interest.

The Present Scenario of Intellectual Property Rights in India

In the 1980s and 1990s, India began to open up its economy and integrate with the global market, which led to a greater emphasis on the protection of Intellectual Property Rights as a means to attract foreign investment and technology. In 1994, India became a signatory to the Agreement on Trade-Related Aspects of Intellectual Property (TRIPS) under the World Trade Organization (WTO), which required India to bring its intellectual property laws in line with international standards.

Since then, India has revised its intellectual property laws several times to comply with its obligations under TRIPS and other international agreements, while also trying to balance the interests of domestic inventors and consumers with those of foreign corporations. Some of the key reforms include the introduction of product patents for pharmaceuticals in 2005, the amendment of the Copyright Act in 2012, and the adoption of a National IPR Policy in 2016 to promote innovation, entrepreneurship, and access to knowledge.

The history of intellectual property rights in India has been shaped by a complex interplay of historical, economic, and political factors, as well as by the evolving global intellectual property regime. While India has made significant progress in protecting and promoting intellectual property rights over the years, there are still challenges and controversies surrounding issues such as patentability, copyright infringement, and access to essential medicines and technologies.



#### Patent System for Protection of Scientific Inventions

In commemoration of World IPR Day, the IPR Cell organized a Special Lecture on Intellectual Property Rights on 26/04/2022 at 1.30 p.m. in collaboration with IQAC. 26 students along with teacher member of the cell were participated in the programme. In the Indian context, in 1856, the Act VI on protection of inventions based on the British Patent Law of 1852 was established. During this period certain privileges were granted to inventors of new manufacturers for a period of 14 year. In 1859, the act was modified as Act XV in which making, selling, using of inventions in India and authorizing others to do so for 14 year from the date of filing the specification. In 1872, the act was re-named as The Patents and Design Protection Act, in 1883 as The Protection of Inventions Act, in 1888 consolidated as The Inventions and Designs Act and in 1911 as The Indian Patents and Designs Act.

Through a patent, the government gives you, the inventor, the right to stop others from making, using or selling your invention from the day the patent is granted to a maximum of 20 years after the day on which you filed your patent application. Patent protection is granted for an invention, a product, or a process, which brings a new technical solution. The invention, which is to be protected by a patent, must be new, useful, functional, and innovative, i.e., solution, for which the patent protection is sought, should not be an obvious one.

As part of the three-stage frame to comply with TRIPS, India passed the Patents (Amendment) Ordinance, 2004. In section 2 of the Patents Act, 1970 definition and interpretation of Budapest Treaty was included. It means the Budapest Treaty on International recognition of the deposition of microorganisms for the purposes of patent procedure done at Budapest on April 28, 1977, as amended and modified from time to time. Section 3 of the Patents Act, 1970 relating to inventions where only methods or processes of manufacture patentable are omitted. The Act gave provisions for patenting a process as well as a product.

In section 7 of the Patents Act, 1970 the filing date of an application referred to in sub-section (1A) shall be considered as the international filing date accorded under the "Patent Cooperation Treaty". The sections 22, 23 and 24 dealing with acceptance, advertisement and effect of acceptance of complete specification are omitted. The sections 24A, 24B, 24C, 24D, 24E and 24F of the Patents Act, 1970 dealing with mainly Exclusive Marketing Rights are omitted indicating that a provision being made during the transition period. A new section 92 A, was introduced for grant of compulsory license for manufacture or export to any country, which has insufficient, or no manufacturing facility provided an application is made by the convention country.


