





REPORT:

The session was a single talk event which commenced with a formal introduction of the speaker who is a retired Professor of the English Department of Visva Bharati, a Central University. Prof. Goutam Ghosal was able to ignite a rejuvenating interest in Romantic Poetry through his wonderful deliberation on Romantic Literature from an entirely new perspective which tried to situate the Romantic Poets in the broader scenario of the history of English Literature by claiming that Romantic Poets were actually trying to bring a different kind of Enlightenment through their poetry. Being an enthusiast in the philosophical beliefs of Sri Aurobindo, Prof. Ghosal insisted on the concept of the inner conscious being which could be reflected in poems by Wordsworth, Coleridge, Byron and Shelley. Prof. Ghosal emphasized on the different aspects of Enlightenment which can only happen with the broadening of the human conscience through experience and understanding of the subtle forces embedded in Nature and then proceeded on with his elaboration of the topic with reference to works of particular Romantic Poets.

The lecture was very well received by a number of 82 participants as they could gather a different kind of knowledge about the Romantic poems which were not a part of the curriculum. They were able to relate with the speaker's lucid way of delivering the issue as he had referred to some of the very interesting and popular poems by particular Romantic poets in order to keep the students interested throughout the Lecture. The session ended with a vote of thanks from one of the teachers of the Department and the students were informed about the tentative schedule of the next day's Lecture.







REPORT:

This was the third invited Lecture in the Online Lecture series which has been continuing over the virtual platform owing to the inability of organizing them in the College Campus due to closure of institutions for the worldwide Pandemic. Prof. Sarani Ghosal Mondal is a veteran in the field of Romantic Poetry constructed by lesser known Poets of the Romantic Age. More than 50 participants had joi9ned this lecture. The students and the teachers were deeply influenced by the poets chosen by her to develop a comparative analysis between them. The speaker talked about a lesser known poet named Felicia Hemans and compared her works with that of other Romantic poets like Shelley and Keats. The speaker talked about poems like 'Dirge', 'Casabianca' and 'The Stately Homes of England'. She compared them with a few poems from Shelley and Keats. The elements of female identity, sensitivity, melancholy, cheerfulness etc as could be found in her poems became the topic of comparison with other poems by Keats and Shelley. It was more of a celebration of the feminine voice in the poems of Hemans for Prof. Mondal, that became the central argument in her lecture.

The participants joined from all over the virtual platform as the lecture was made open to all. It was a remarkable experience for all of us as the speaker's unconventional deliberation on Romantic Poems ushered a lot of questions and observations from the participants.

REPORT:





INTRODUCTION AND HISTORY OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS IN INDIA

In commemoration of World IPR Day, the IPR Cell in collaboration with IQAC organized a Online Special Lecture on Intellectual Property Rights on 26/04/2021 at 6.30 p.m. It was conducted through Team Link Platform. The history of intellectual property rights in India can be traced back to the British colonial period when the first copyright and patent laws were introduced in the mid-19th century. However, these laws were primarily designed to serve the interests of British entrepreneurs and did not take into account the needs and aspirations of Indian inventors and creators.

After India gained independence in 1947, the government took several steps to promote indigenous innovation and creativity and protect the Intellectual Property Rights for indian citizens. In 1957, the Indian Patent Act was enacted, which established a system of patent registration and protection that was more accessible and affordable for Indian inventors and entrepreneurs.

In the 1960s and 1970s, the Indian government implemented a series of policies to promote self-reliance and reduce dependence on foreign technology and capital. These policies included the development of indigenous technologies, the creation of public research institutions, and the establishment of a legal framework that allowed for the compulsory licensing of patents in certain cases of national interest.

The Present Scenario of Intellectual Property Rights in India

In the 1980s and 1990s, India began to open up its economy and integrate with the global market, which led to a greater emphasis on the protection of Intellectual Property Rights as a means to attract foreign investment and technology. In 1994, India became a signatory to the Agreement on Trade-Related Aspects of Intellectual Property (TRIPS) under the World Trade Organization (WTO), which required India to bring its intellectual property laws in line with international standards.

Since then, India has revised its intellectual property laws several times to comply with its obligations under TRIPS and other international agreements, while also trying to balance the interests of domestic inventors and consumers with those of foreign corporations. Some of the key reforms include the introduction of product patents for pharmaceuticals in 2005, the amendment of the Copyright Act in 2012, and the adoption of a National IPR Policy in 2016 to promote innovation, entrepreneurship, and access to knowledge.

The history of intellectual property rights in India has been shaped by a complex interplay of historical, economic, and political factors, as well as by the evolving global intellectual property regime. While India has made significant progress in protecting and promoting intellectual property rights over the years, there are still challenges and controversies surrounding issues such as patentability, copyright infringement, and access to essential medicines and technologies.
