

#### REPORT:

A total number of 20 students participated in the Course conducted chiefly by three invited Resource persons from three educational institutions and the teachers of the English Department of this institution. It was held over Google Meet in two sessions each day for the entire Course.

It began with a lecture delivered by Bidyut Kumar Mondal who elaborated on the topic of Communication Skills while reading GB Shaw's text on 'Spoken English and Broken English' on the first day of the Course. The two other Soft Skill topics like Teamwork and Collaboration and 'Time Management' were taken up by Kyamalia Bairagya on the scheduled days. Aditi Bandyopadyay spoke on the importance of 'Problem Solving' from her reading of Frank Stockton's Dr Arnab Chatterjee attempted an analysis of 'Emotional short story 'The Lady or the Tiger'. Intelligence' from his reading of Robinson Crusoc. The soft skill of 'Creativity' was handled by Bidhan Mondal through his fascinating reading of 'Daffodils' and 'The Solitary Reaper' by William Wordsworth .
