



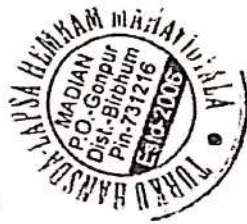

Course Objectives

1. Introducing the participants to the very interesting concept of acquiring the knowledge of various soft skills through a relevant set of texts chosen from the vast range of literary productions in English Literature.
2. To help the students identify and acknowledge the necessity of cultivating soft skills in various aspects of their lives. Although a prerequisite in the essential field of seeking employment, being students of literature the need to be able to develop soft skills among them as essential qualities in communication and writing is also another objective of this Course.
3. Special emphasis will be given on the chosen texts and a contextual reading of these texts will also be done by the respective speakers of the Course.

Course Outcomes

It is expected that the students and teachers will develop a better understanding of the need to develop soft skills in their day to day activities with the aim of enhancing the teaching learning process. The students will hopefully be able to grapple with new and unknown texts lying outside their syllabus and discover about their application in the world outside their educational institution and the significance of various soft skills found in the select group of texts. It will also help them in the creative field of writing.

The Online Soft Skill Course is divided into eight days and each soft skill will be discussed through a detailed reading of the relevant texts and other important discussion by the speakers so that the students may have enough exposure to those skills as well as the texts. 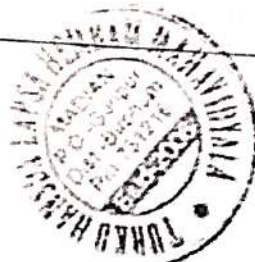

REPORT:

An Online Soft Skill Course on the topic 'Learning Soft Skills through English Literature' was arranged by the Faculty members of the English Department for the willing students of Sem 1 (NEP) in the academic session of 2023- 2024 with the objective to acquaint them with the various kind of soft skills that could also be learned from literary texts. This was in continuation with the Soft Skill Course conducted in the previous academic session by the English Department. The Course was of an 8 days and 32 hours tenure held from 13/11/2023- 20/11/2023 in the online mode in this academic session. A total number of 20 students participated in the Course conducted chiefly by three invited Resource persons from three educational institutions and the teachers of the English Department of this institution. It was held over Google Meet in two sessions each day for the entire Course.

It began with a lecture delivered by Bidyut Kumar Mondal who elaborated on the topic of Communication Skills while reading GB Shaw's text on 'Spoken English and Broken English' on the first day of the Course. The two other Soft Skill topics like Teamwork and Collaboration and 'Time Management' were taken up by Kyamalia Bairagya on the scheduled days. Aditi Bandyopadyay spoke on the importance of 'Problem Solving' from her reading of Frank Stockton's short story 'The Lady or the Tiger'. Dr Arnab Chatterjee attempted an analysis of 'Emotional Intelligence' from his reading of Robinson Crusoe. The soft skill of 'Creativity' was handled by Bidhan Mondal through his fascinating reading of 'Daffodils' and 'The Solitary Reaper' by William Wordsworth. The soft skill of 'Adaptability' was an appropriate topic taken up by Mrigen Mondal which could be interpreted from the kind of acceptance of fate which could be found in the characters of Maurya and her family. A basic analysis of the necessity of developing 'Leadership' qualities through a reading of *Alice in Wonderland* was done by Oendri Chatteraj and a general 'Group discussion' among students was done by available teachers of the Department in the second session of the last day based on which the assessment sheet was made.

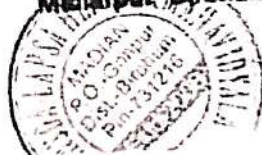


