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#### Initiatives taken as Per Recommendation of the 1st Cycle NAAC Peer Team

- 1. All vacancies related to teaching posts have been recruited by the WBCSC according to Government norms. No new posts have been created by the Government for the College. Considering the shortage of work force in subjects like Philosophy, Physical Education, and in the Library, there remains the necessity of creating new posts in these areas.
- 2. Since there has been a very limited amount of fund generation in the institution in the last five years, teachers are requested to apply for grants through minor Research Projects and the Research Cell of the College has been making constant efforts in the area of encouraging and assisting the faculty members for the above cause.
- 3. A separate Computer laboratory has been established for students with only a limited number of Computers due to a severe constraint in the availability of funds with the institution.
- 4. Although a fund constraint is a constant hindrance to all infrastructural developments, the laboratories of Chemistry, Physics and Geography have been developed for a better delivery of the Science based subjects in the curriculum.
- 5. In the last five years a total number of 25 Add on Courses and 7 skill development courses have been arranged by 12 departments of the institution in collaboration with the IQAC.
- 6. The Career Guidance and Placement Cell of the institution has been trying to build a career oriented set of learners by imparting subject based information on the availability of jobs and other employment possibilities through the arrangement of awareness programs in collaboration with the IQAC on Career opportunities for students in subjects available in the academic curriculum of the institution.
- 7. Any kind of funds are not available from the UGC at present due to which the institution has not been able to build the Girls' Hostel or develop the hostel for tribal boys located within the institution.



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- 8. The sports grounds have been redeveloped for the purpose of annual sports and DPI sports in the last five years. It has however not been possible to add any new equipment in the department of Physical Education due to insufficient financial resources in the institution.
- 9. The institution is concerned about the poor class attendance of the students in almost all subjects and this issue has been raised in the GB for allowing the College to take necessary actions.
- 10. The IQAC has been trying its best to make all kind of academic, financial and cultural developments within the institution and keep the internal mechanism of the institution active to meet the demands of the changing patterns in the Curriculum.
- 11. There is very little demand for Commerce based courses in this area of the state due to which the College has never faced any such requirement in the last few years. The Government is not supportive of introducing any new Science based Courses in the institution. Efforts were made by sending official requests to get the chances of introducing the Honours Course in Political Science and open a PG Course in Santali but there has been no affirmation on this topic.
- 12. The Central Library has been made more resourceful by a significant addition to the total number of books available in it. It has been semi digitized and upgraded from Soul 2.0 to Soul 3.0. The Enlist e-journal has been subscribed.
- 13. The institution has tried to fulfil most of the recommendations of the Peer team visit in the first cycle of NAAC which was held in 2016. The institution has only completed 18 years of its journey and although it has been accredited with grade B in the first cycle, there has not been any fund allotment for any kind of developments since 2016. There has not been any financial assistance either from any State or Central government or from the IMP or MLA lad. The only financial support available for the institution is the tuition fees of the admitted students and it has been suffering from severe fund constraints in all these years. Despite all hindrances, the institution is hoping that acquiring a decent grade in the second cycle of NAAC will enable it to obtain the vision of evolving into one of the most trusted educational institutions of the state in near future.
