# I. Introduction *Prelude*

Turku Hansda Lapsa Hemram Mahavidyalay, Madian, Mallarpur, Birbhum was established on 1<sup>st</sup> of August 2006 as general degree college to cater the need of higher education to the socio-economically backward class of rural students. The College was named after the two great tribal leaders Turku Hansda and Lapsa Hemram. The College possesses a beautiful lush green ambience. The canopy of shal and mahuya forest provides carbon neutrality and also hosts a wide variety of birds. Presently, there are 8 subjects with Honours and 3 General subjects and one professional course on Physical Education. It is affiliated to the University of Burdwan. During these two decades College has developed an infrastructure accommodating different subjects; now it stands as a testament to the commitment to educational accessibility, addressing the needs of the local students and fostering a conducive environment for higher learning.

Library has a Reading Zone for students and teachers, one playground, courts for playing outdoor games. College possesses a green ambience and a pond inside. College provides academic facilities like learning atmosphere, partially automated Library facility, etc.

In 2016, during First Cycle of NAAC accreditation College obtained a Grade of B and now is preparing for Second Cycle of assessment. The College voluntarily has started the academic & administrative audit for the last few years of 2018-'19 to 2022-'23 to look into its strengths and weaknesses and identify the scope of further improvement.

Based on the departmental profile, information/data presented by the Head/Coordinator, from the available documents and the interactions with the Head/Coordinator relating to different components of the department/institution, the Audit Committee has made a sincere endeavour to put forward certain views, observations and recommendations in the body of this report with expectations that these recommendations, when implemented, will best serve the interest of the College as intended.

- College has Rainwater Harvesting System.
- College provides free Wi-Fi facility with a bandwidth of >100 Mbps.
- Library is semi-automated using Integrated Library Management System (ILMS) Data, at present library has a total of 9920 printed books. Library uses SOUL 3.0.
- No new minor or major projects during the year of assessment.
- College has introduced **25** Add-on courses for creation/generation of job opportunities and become employable.
- Overall pass percentage is satisfactory.
- Most of the teachers are well-experienced; 12 teachers have been awarded PhD.
- Few teachers pursue research works in their personal capacity.
- The support staffs are very happy with the College Administration.
- College has two units of NSS and one unit of NCC and are efficiently undertaking community services; they conduct outreach programmes on regular basis; organize Green Campus Programs and maintain one adopted village also.
- Some of the best practices such as campus cleaning, maintaining tree plantation, floral biodiversity register, and introducing plastic free zone, No Smoking Zone, *etc.*, are followed in the campus.
- College has Alumni Association, established on 2015.

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- All teaching and non-teaching staff members, and students are aware about cleanliness and hygiene, water conservation, *etc*.
- The IOAC conducts its tasks efficiently

- There are total 33 Classrooms, 02 Halls, 03 ICT enabled Class rooms, 04 laboratories including Computer Lab.

- ✓ More number of teachers will be included in the University administration/academic part.
- ✓ More number of skill development courses be introduced for the benefit of the students and creation of job opportunities.






