



## **I. Introduction**

### ***Prelude***

Turku Hansda Lapsa Hemram Mahavidyalay, Madian, Mallarpur, Birbhum was established on 1<sup>st</sup> of August 2006 as general degree college to cater the need of higher education to the socio-economically backward class of rural students. The canopy of shal and mahuya forest provides carbon neutrality and also hosts a wide variety of birds. Presently, there are 8 subjects with Honours and 3 General subjects and one professional course on Physical Education. It is affiliated to the University of Burdwan. During these two decades College has developed an infrastructure accommodating different subjects; now it stands as a testament to the commitment to educational accessibility, addressing the needs of the local students and fostering a conducive environment for higher learning.

Library has a Reading Zone for students and teachers, one playground, courts for playing outdoor games. College possesses a green ambience and a pond inside. College provides academic facilities like learning atmosphere, partially automated Library facility, etc.

In 2016, during First Cycle of NAAC accreditation College obtained a Grade of B and now is preparing for Second Cycle of assessment. The College voluntarily has started the academic & administrative audit for the last few years of 2018-'19 to 2022-'23 to look into its strengths and weaknesses and identify the scope of further improvement.

- College provides free Wi-Fi facility with a bandwidth of >100 Mbps.
- Library is semi-automated using Integrated Library Management System (ILMS) Data, at present library has a total of 9920 printed books. Library uses SOUL 3.0.
- No new minor or major projects during the year of assessment.
- College has introduced **25** Add-on courses for creation/generation of job opportunities and become employable.
- Overall pass percentage is satisfactory.
- Most of the teachers are well-experienced; 12 teachers have been awarded PhD.
- Few teachers pursue research works in their personal capacity.
- The support staffs are very happy with the College Administration.
- College has two units of NSS and one unit of NCC and are efficiently undertaking community services; they conduct outreach programmes on regular basis; organize Green Campus Programs and maintain one adopted village also.
- Some of the best practices such as campus cleaning, maintaining tree plantation, floral biodiversity register, and introducing plastic free zone, No Smoking Zone, etc., are followed in the campus.
- College has Alumni Association, established on 2015.

- ✓ Department should take more initiative to prepare progression of the students in regard to academic as well as employment.
- ✓ More number of teachers will be included in the University administration/academic part.
- ✓ More number of skill development courses be introduced for the benefit of the students and creation of job opportunities.

- ❖ 'Soil and Water Testing' process be developed for making the outreach programmes in serving the society, local people and Chemistry Department be associated with this programmes.
- ❖ Department should choose more skill-oriented courses, field-oriented studies for the

সিউড়ি বিদ্যাসাগর কলেজ  
বীরভূমের থ্রেসিডেন্সি  
কলেজ পরিচিতি। ৭৯ বছর  
পেরিয়ে এসেছে এই কলেজ। অন্য  
দিকে, মাত্র ২০০৬ সালে যাত্রা শুরু  
করবে মল্লারপুরের টুরকু হাঁসদা  
লপসা হেমব্রহ্ম মহাবিদ্যালয়।  
দুটি শিক্ষা প্রতিষ্ঠানই উচ্চশিক্ষা প্রসারের  
উচ্চতর পদক্ষেপ নিয়েছে।  
তবে বয়স, পরিকল্পনা বিচারে  
দুটি কলেজের মধ্যে তুলনামূলক  
আলোচনা কোথায় করা উচিত নয়।  
তবুও একটি বিষয় দুটি কলেজকেই  
এক বিদ্যুতের সীল করিয়ে দিয়েছে।  
সেটা হল উৎকর্ষতা বৃদ্ধির লক্ষ্য।

সম্মতি দেশের সব উচ্চশিক্ষা  
প্রতিষ্ঠানকে নিয়ে কেন্দ্রীয় মানসম্পন্ন  
উন্নয়ন মন্ত্রকের প্রকাশিত রাঙ্কিং  
(এনআইআরএফ) -এ যুগের  
মধ্যে স্থান গ্রহণে বীরভূমের এই  
দুই কলেজের। তবে সর্বভারতীয়  
জেলার দুই উচ্চশিক্ষা প্রতিষ্ঠানের  
অনুষ্ঠান টিক কোথায়, সেটা  
সুঝতেই এনআইআরএফ অংশ  
নিয়ত ছিল জেলার দুটি কলেজ।  
বিদ্যাসাগর কলেজের অধ্যক্ষ  
তপনকুমার পরিচ্যা এবং মল্লারপুর  
কলেজের অধ্যক্ষ অমিত চক্রবর্তীরা  
জানিয়েছিলেন, এই প্রথম উভয়েই  
পাঠে সর্বভারতীয় স্তরে র‌্যাঙ্কিংয়ে  
স্থান পাওয়া উচ্চশিক্ষা প্রতিষ্ঠানগুলির  
তুলনায় পিছিয়ে থেকেও কেন  
এনআইআরএফ অংশ নেওয়া হয়েছে।  
কিন্তু, রাঙ্কিংয়ে স্থান পাওয়ার প্রত্যাশা  
নয়, বরং শিক্ষা প্রতিষ্ঠানের উন্নতিতে  
কী কী পরামর্শ দেওয়া উচিত, কোন  
কোন দিকে রাষ্ট্রের মজুর নেওয়া উচিত

সেটা উপলব্ধি করাই উদ্দেশ্য ছিল।  
কেন্দ্রীয় মানসম্পন্ন উন্নয়ন  
মন্ত্রকের বেশ ছুটে কলেজ ও  
বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়গুলির সর্বভারতীয়  
রাঙ্কিং এর উদ্দেশ্যও তাই। হাজার  
হাজার উচ্চ শিক্ষা প্রতিষ্ঠান থেকে  
রাঙ্কিংয়ের জন্য ব্যবহৃত উপকার  
মানসম্পন্নদের নিরিখে নিজেদের  
মূল্যায়ন করিয়ে নেয়, এবং যোগ্যত  
হেতে পরবর্তী বছরগুলিতে তাদের

শিক্ষার নিয়ে যাওয়ার ক্ষেত্রে এবং  
হাস্টলের কর্মসম্পন্নদের সুযোগ করে  
দিতে সার্বিকভাবে কী কী ক্রমিক পালন  
করবে মূল্যায়নের ক্ষেত্রে সেটাই  
বিশেষ গ্যারান্টি পাওয়া যায়। নিজেদেরকে  
শ্রেষ্ঠায় এনআইআরএফ যাচাই  
করিয়ে নেওয়ার পিছনে জেলার দুই  
নবীণ ও প্রবীণ শিক্ষা প্রতিষ্ঠানের  
ইচ্ছেটাকে কুনিশ করতে হয়।

নিজেদের শিক্ষা প্রতিষ্ঠানকে  
সেবার হালিকায় নিয়ে যাওয়া এই  
ওই অধ্যক্ষ হঠাৎ নয়, নিরন্তর।  
দুটি শিক্ষা প্রতিষ্ঠান কীভাবে সেই  
লক্ষ্যে এগিয়ে চলবে কয়েকটি  
উদাহরণেই সেটা স্পষ্ট হবে।  
প্রথমে আসা যাক সিউড়ি বিদ্যাসাগর  
কলেজ প্রসঙ্গে। ইতিহাস বলছে,  
২ মার্চ, ১৯৪২ সালে কলকাতা  
বিদ্যাসাগর কলেজের প্রাক্তন ছাত্র  
শ্রী আনিবাল মিত্র মহাশয়ের  
সত্যাগতির কলেজটি কলকাতা

বিদ্যাসাগর কলেজের শাখা হিসাবে  
যাত্রা শুরু করে।  
কলেজের প্রথম পঠন-পাঠন শুরু  
হয় শহরের শ্রী অমিত্যচরণের কাশী  
মন্দিরে (কাশীবাড়ি)। পরে ১৯৪২  
সালের জুন মাসে নতুন ভবনটিতে  
কলেজটি স্থানান্তর রিত হয়। ১৯৪৪  
সালে কলকাতা বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ের  
অনুমোদন পায়। ৬০ সালে বর্তমান  
বিশ্ববিদ্যালয় গঠনের পরে এই কলেজ  
বর্তমানে বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ের আওতায়  
আসে।

কলেজ সূত্রে জানা বিয়োগে, ৯  
একক জায়গার উপরে গড়ে ওঠা  
৬ই কলেজে ৭টি বিদ্যালয় সিন্ডিকেট  
হয়েছে পঠনপাঠনের জন্য। ছাত্র  
ও ছাত্রীদের দুটি আবাস রয়েছে।  
প্রয়োজনীয় ল্যাবরেটরি, বাসেট ও  
ভলিবল খেলার মাঠ রয়েছে কলেজ  
চত্বরে। ৬ই কলেজ দেশের প্রাক্তন  
রাষ্ট্রপতি প্রমথ মুখোপাধ্যায় ছাত্রের  
থ্রেসিডেন্সী কলেজের প্রাক্তন অধ্যক্ষ  
অমল মুখোপাধ্যায়, রবীন্দ্রভারতী  
বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ের প্রাক্তন উপাচার্য  
কলকান্দিলাস, প্রাক্তন উপাচার্য  
রমারঞ্জন মুখোপাধ্যায়, বর্তমান  
বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ের প্রাক্তন অধ্যাপক  
বেবরঞ্জন মুখোপাধ্যায় প্রমুখ  
পড়াশোনা করেছেন। বর্তমানে  
পড়ুয়ার সংখ্যা চার হাজারেরও বেশি।  
পূর্ণ সময়ে শিক্ষকের সংখ্যা আশি

মাত্র এক যুগ আগে গড়ে ওঠা কলেজটিকে উচ্চশিক্ষা  
প্রসার উপরের সারিতে নিয়ে আসার চেষ্টায় অবশ্য  
ঘাটতি নেই। পঠনপাঠনে যত্ন নেওয়া তো আছেই।  
যুগের সঙ্গে তাল মিলিয়ে ওয়াই-ফাই ক্যাম্পাস, কলেজ  
চত্বরে উন্নত খেলার মাঠ গড়ে তোলা, লাইব্রেরির সমস্ত  
বইয়ের ডিজিটাল কাটলগ তৈরি করা, বায়োমেট্রিক  
হাজিরা পদ্ধতি চালু-সহ নানা ব্যবস্থা রয়েছে।

জন। অন্যদিকে বিজ্ঞান ও

বিষয়ে। লাইব্রেরির সমস্ত বইয়ের  
ডিজিটাল কাটলগ তৈরি করা,  
বিশেষ চাইল সম্প্রদায়ের জন্য প্রতিটি  
ভবনে বয়স্ক তৈরি করা, বসায়ন

৬ই কলেজকে বি++ গ্রেড দিয়েছে।  
এ বার আসা যাক মল্লারপুরের টুরকু  
হাঁসদা লপসা হেমব্রহ্ম মহাবিদ্যালয়

প্রসঙ্গে। কলেজের ইতিহাসে বলছে,  
স্থানীয় দুই অধিবাসী নেত্রী প্রমথ বাম  
বিদ্যায়ক টুরকু হাঁসদা এবং স্থানীয় গণ  
আন্দোলনের নেত্রী লপসা হেমব্রহ্মের  
নামেই কলেজ। রাজ্য সরকারের  
অনুমোদন পেয়েছিল ২০০৬  
এর অক্টোবরে। কলেজটি গড়ে  
তোলার পিছনে গুরুত্বপূর্ণ অবদান  
রয়েছে তৎকালীন কেন্দ্র পরিষদের  
সভাপতি রঞ্জ মুখোপাধ্যায়ের।

তবে মাত্র এক যুগ আগে গড়ে  
ওঠা সেই কলেজটিকে উচ্চশিক্ষা

প্রসার উপরের সারিতে নিয়ে  
আসার চেষ্টায় অবশ্য  
পঠনপাঠনে যত্ন নেওয়া তো  
ঘুগের সঙ্গে তাল মিলিয়ে ওয়াই  
ফাই ক্যাম্পাস, কলেজ  
চত্বরে উন্নত খেলার মাঠ গড়ে তোলা,  
লাইব্রেরির সমস্ত  
বইয়ের ডিজিটাল কাটলগ  
তৈরি করা, বায়োমেট্রিক হাজিরা  
পদ্ধতি চালু-সহ নানা ব্যবস্থা রয়েছে।  
২০১৭ সালে এই কলেজ থেকেই  
সীওহালিতে বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ের উপরে  
হয়েছেন। কলেজ গড়ার দশ বছরের  
মাধ্যমে মালশাল অ্যাসেসমেন্ট অ্যান্ড  
আর্কিভিটেকশন কর্তৃপক্ষ (নাক)-

২.১০ পেয়ে বি গ্রেড পেয়েছিল  
কলেজ। তবে ২.০ এর নীচে পাওয়ায়  
রাষ্ট্রীয় উচ্চশিক্ষা অধিদপ্তরের তরফে  
যে বছর কলেজ টিকা বরাদ্দ রয়েছে  
সেটা পায়নি কলেজ।

যাত্রা সরকারের উচ্চশিক্ষা  
দপ্তর থেকে আর কোনও  
আর্থিক সাহায্য মেলেনি। কলে ইচ্ছে  
ধাকলেও পরিকল্পনামূলক ১৬ সালের  
পর থেকে নতুন করে উন্নতি ঘটানো  
সম্ভব হয়নি। কিন্তু, হেরে যাওয়া নয়  
বরং লড়াইয়ে থাকতে চেয়েছে শিক্ষা  
প্রতিষ্ঠান, সেটা এনআইআরএফ  
অংশ নেওয়া থেকে পরিত্যক্ত।  
দুটি কলেজ জানিয়েছে,  
এনআইআরএফ আবেদনের ক্ষেত্রে  
নাকের মূল্যায়ন হওয়া বাঞ্ছনীয়।  
সেটা হয়ে থাকলে একটি পরিকল্পনামূলক  
গত একটি মানদণ্ড থাকেই। এর পর  
এনআইআরএফ এ আবেদন করতে  
যে যে বিদ্যালয় লিপ্সা হয় সেগুলির  
মধ্যে রয়েছে গত তিন বছর ধরে

যাওয়া গিয়েছে। গ্রেসমেন্ট কেমন।  
পিএইচডি শিক্ষকেরা কোন কোন  
বিষয়ে গবেষণা করেছেন। বিশেষ  
চাইল সম্পন্ন শিক্ষক ও পড়ুয়ার  
জানা কলেজের কী কী সুবিধা রয়েছে  
এমন নানা তথ্য নিয়েই আবেদন  
করতে হয়েছিল।

যে সব কলেজ সর্বভারতীয়  
র‌্যাঙ্কিংয়ে এসেছে সেগুলি অনেক  
এগিয়ে। বিশেষ করে মফসসলের  
কলেজগুলিতে পড়ুয়ারের রূপ  
অটুটের সংখ্যা পাস-কোর্সে ভর্তি  
হওয়া পড়ুয়ারের) যথেষ্ট বেশি।  
সমস্যা রয়েছে পড়ুয়ারের মেসমেন্ট ও  
কলেজ থেকে বেরিয়ে গিয়ে উচ্চতর  
শিক্ষার নিয়ে যাওয়ার বিষয়েও। সেই  
জন্যই ব্যক্তির থেকে পিছিয়ে যেতে  
হয়েছে।

তবে আগামী দিনে কী ভাবে  
এগানো যায় সেটা নিয়ে জাবনা  
শুরু করেছে দুটি অসমবর্তী শিক্ষা  
প্রতিষ্ঠান।

# দু'শোতেই নেই, খামতি জানতে মাঠে

এনআইআরএফ-এর মূল্যায়নে প্রথম একশোয় জায়গা পেয়েছে রাজ্যের সাতটি কলেজ। সেই তালিকায় অবশ্যই জেলার কোনও কলেজের নাম নেই। তবে প্রতিযোগিতায় ছিল জেলার কলেজও। এই প্রথমবার তাতে যোগ দিয়েছিল সিউডি বিদ্যাসাগর কলেজ ও মল্লারপুরের টুরকু হাঁসদা লপসা হেমরম মহাবিদ্যালয়। তবে প্রথম দুশোর মধ্যেই নাম নেই দুই কলেজের। তার জন্য হতাশা নয়, বরং সেটাকে ইতিবাচক হিসেবেই দেখছেন দুটি কলেজের অধ্যক্ষ।

বিদ্যাসাগর কলেজের অধ্যক্ষ তপনকুমার পরিচ্ছা এবং মল্লারপুর কলেজের অধ্যক্ষ অমিত চক্রবর্তীরা জানাচ্ছেন, সর্বভারতীয় প্রতিযোগিতায় না যোগ না দিলে শিক্ষা প্রতিষ্ঠানের উন্নতিতে কী কী পদক্ষেপ নেওয়া উচিত, কোন কোন দিকে বাড়তি নজর দিতেই এমন ভাবনা। তাঁদের কথায়, “সর্বভারতীয় স্তরে আমাদের উচ্চশিক্ষা প্রতিষ্ঠানের অবস্থান ঠিক কোথায় সেটা বুঝতেই এনআইআরএফ অংশ নেওয়া। র‍্যাঙ্কিং নিয়ে ভাবিনি।”

দুটি শিক্ষা প্রতিষ্ঠান সূত্র খবর, ন্যাশনাল অ্যাসেসমেন্ট অ্যান্ড অ্যাক্রিডিটেশন কাউন্সিল (নাক)-এর ভিজিট যে সব কলেজে হয়েছে সেখানে পরিকাঠামো গত মানোন্নয়ন হয়ে

দুটি সেই মানদণ্ড পেরিয়ে এসেছে। এর পর এনআইআরএফ এ আবেদন করতে যে যে বিষয়গুলি দেখা হয় সেগুলির মধ্যে রয়েছে গত তিন বছর ধরে শিক্ষা প্রতিষ্ঠানে পড়ুয়ার সংখ্যা। পড়ুয়া-শিক্ষকের অনুপাত। পরীক্ষার ফল। ছাত্রীর সংখ্যা। পিছিয়ে পড়া ছাত্র ও ছাত্রীর সংখ্যা। তাঁদের কত জনকে পোস্ট গ্রাজুয়েট বা তার থেকে উচ্চতর শিক্ষায় বা গবেষণায় নিয়ে যাওয়া গিয়েছে। প্লেসমেন্ট কেমন। পিএইচডি শিক্ষকেরা কোন কোন বিষয়ে গবেষণা করেছেন। বিশেষ চাহিদা সম্পন্ন শিক্ষক ও পড়ুয়াদের জন্য কলেজে কী কী সুবিধা রয়েছে এমন নানা তথ্য। যথাযথ তথ্য নির্দিষ্ট ওয়েবসাইটে আপলোড করতে হয়। যাতে কারও কোনও আপত্তি থাকলে সেটা সামনে আসে। এরপরে মূল্যায়ন করার দায়িত্ব কেন্দ্রীয় মানবসম্পদ উন্নয়ন মন্ত্রকের ওই বিভাগের।

কলেজ মূলত কোথায় পিছিয়ে?

দুটি কলেজের অধ্যক্ষের অভিজ্ঞতা বলছেন, “মফস্সলের কলেজগুলিতে পড়ুয়াদের ড্রপ আউটের সংখ্যা (বিশেষ করে পাস কোর্সে ভর্তি হওয়া পড়ুয়াদের) যথেষ্টই বেশি। সমস্যা রয়েছে পড়ুয়াদের প্লেসমেন্ট ও কলেজ থেকে বেরিয়ে গিয়ে উচ্চতর শিক্ষায় নিয়ে যাওয়ার বিষয়েও। সেই জনাই বাকিদের থেকে পিছিয়ে যেতে হয়েছে। আগামী দিনে সেই সব বিষয়ে নজর দেওয়া হবে।” দুটি কলেজের শিক্ষকদের আশা, আগামী দিনে নিশ্চয়ই তাঁদের শিক্ষা প্রতিষ্ঠান ভাল জায়গা পাবে। শুধু কলেজ শিক্ষক বা বর্তমান পড়ুয়ারা থেকে প্রতিষ্ঠিত প্রাক্তনীদের মিলিত চেষ্টা প্রয়োজন।
