Academic Session: 2022-2023

A REPORT ON ADD-ON COURSE YOGA & MEDITATION COURSE

The Department of Physical Education, Turku Hansda lapsa Hemram Mahavidyalay conducted an add-on Certificate Course in Yoga and Meditation on 14th August to 31th August, 2023 in room no 122. The enrollment was for only 100 students based on first come first serve basis. Total 33 students enrolled, and all the students completed for this course. The exam was conducted through practical and viva basis. The certificates were provided duly. This course aimed to provide students with a comprehensive understanding of yoga, its principles, and practical applications. The Certificate Course in Yoga Education provided a solid foundation for individual's interest in pursuing a career in yoga instruction, wellness coaching, or holistic health. By combining theoretical knowledge with practical training, students can enhance their understanding of yoga and contribution to the well-being of others.

"Introduction to Programming Language"

The Mathematics Department of THLH Mahavidyalaya conducted An Add-on Course on "Introduction to Programming Language" for the Hons Students of the Mathematics Department. The total number of enrolled students was 4. All the enrolled Students completed this course successfully. The Course started on 7th January 2023 and it was completed on 21st January 2023. It was a twelve-day course. The course was conducted in a Departmental Classroom (103) and practical classes in the computer lab. Only the inauguration Lecture was held in the Smart Room. All the participants were enjoying the course with good responses and enthusiasm. They performed well in the examination. Certificates were given to all the qualifying students.

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Democratic awareness through local Self-government

The Political Science Department of T.HLH. Mahavidyalay conducted An Add-on Course on Democratic Awareness through local self-government for the GE Political Science students of our college. The total number of enrolled students was 22. All the enrolled students complete this course successfully. The course started 9/3/2023 and completed 15/03/2023. It was a Six-day course. This course was conducted in the Departmental classroom (118). Only the inauguration lecture was held in the smart room. All the participants were enjoying the course with good responses and enthusiasm. They performed well in the examination. Certificates were given to all the qualifying students.

'Children's Literature'

An Add on Certificate Course on the topic of 'Children's Literature' from 9th March 2023 to 17th March 2023 was organized by the teachers of the Department of English of Turku Hansda Lapsa Hemram Mahavidyalay, under the direction of the Principal and guidance of the Coordinator of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell in the Academic Session of 2022- 2023. A total of 29 students from Semester 4 and Semester 2 of the English Department had joined the Course and it was a great success as the students actively participated in the program which continued for a total of 8 days and 32 hours duration. It was an intra- College but interdepartmental program arranged to give a better idea of the chosen sub- genre of Literature. Prof. Chandan Mondal of Bengali department of this institution was also invited to speak about the concept of Children's narratives in Bengali Literature.

The Course was divided into eight days of four hours each. Some days had two sessions by two different speakers scheduled according to the module to avoid the monotony of the Course. The students were introduced about the origin, history and development of this unique genre which can actually accommodate a

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wide variety of texts interesting enough to be read by children and adults simultaneously. Several narratives belonging to this category was taken up in class for preserving the lively spirit within the class. The English department teachers delivered student- friendly bilingual lectures on English and Indian English Children's literary texts. References were drawn from ancient Indian texts like the *Panchatantra* to highlight the importance of works for children in Indian culture as well. The concept of the evolution of the child as a reader in response to adult literary texts was also taken into account. Various modes of representation like the adventure narratives, the science fiction, the gothic, the mysterious etc were considered for discussion. Special attention was given to the sub genres of Comics and Graphic Novels with textual references to substantiate the subtle difference between the two. Popular works for children like that of Satyajit Ray was also an interesting area of study in this Course.

The students were made to submit assignments based on which they were evaluated and certified as active participants of the Course. This Course will chart a different territory for conducting Research works by the interested students as the underlying theoretical issues along with their politics of representation which could be seen to function in many literary narratives meant for children were also raised but unresolved in this Course. Students were curious to know more about this genre and it was a highly successful event organized by the English Department of this institution.

"Exploring the Nexus of the Geography with Other Subjects"

In the academic session of 2022–2023, the teachers of the Department of Geography of Turku Hansda Lapsa Hemram Mahavidyalay organized an Add-on Certificate Course on the topic of "Exploring the Nexus of the Geography with Other Subjects from 04/04/2023 to 13/04/2023 (32 Hours) including two session every day. The course was overseen by the Principal and guided by the Coordinator of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell. In addition to the instructors from the geography department, many speakers from the various departments such as History, Philosophy, Political Science, Chemistry, and Physics were invited to discuss the idea of the existing nexus of geography with various subjects.

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A total of 41 students from the second and fourth semesters participated in the course. In addition to submitting assignments based on the knowledge they had learned from the course, students had to participate in a viva voce. Students received a certificate with their grade listed on it after completing the assignment and viva. Few participants obtained an A+ grade, the majority of students received an A and very few students received a B grade. Upon finishing the course, students have gained a comprehensive understanding of the current

Besides the teachers of the English Department, Dr. Suman Mukherjee, the Head of the Department of History of this institution was invited to deliver a speech on a relevant theme suitable for the topic.

The Course was divided into eight days of four hours each. Some days had two sessions by two different speakers scheduled according to the module to avoid the monotony of the Course. The students were introduced about the origin, history and development of this unique genre of the English Novel which can actually accommodate a wide variety of texts interesting enough to be read by all kind of readers. The various precursory sub- genres responsible for the rise of the novel were discussed by the speakers to expand the horizon of their understanding about the genre. Since they are made to read a number of novels in their Undergraduate Course, a thorough knowledge about the pre- existing literary and non- literary pieces of writing promoting the growth of the genre of the novel was an interesting way to deal with the genre itself. The sociocultural history of England was also discussed by the invited speaker with special emphasis on the eighteenth century England. A number of authors like Daniel Defoe, Samuel Richardson, Henry Fielding, Laurence Sterne, which are not included were also discussed for their contribution to the genre.



Upon finishing the course, students will be able to independently carry out investigation and development work to solve real-life geospatial problems. They will also be able to write and present a substantial technical report/document/international level research article.

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
